



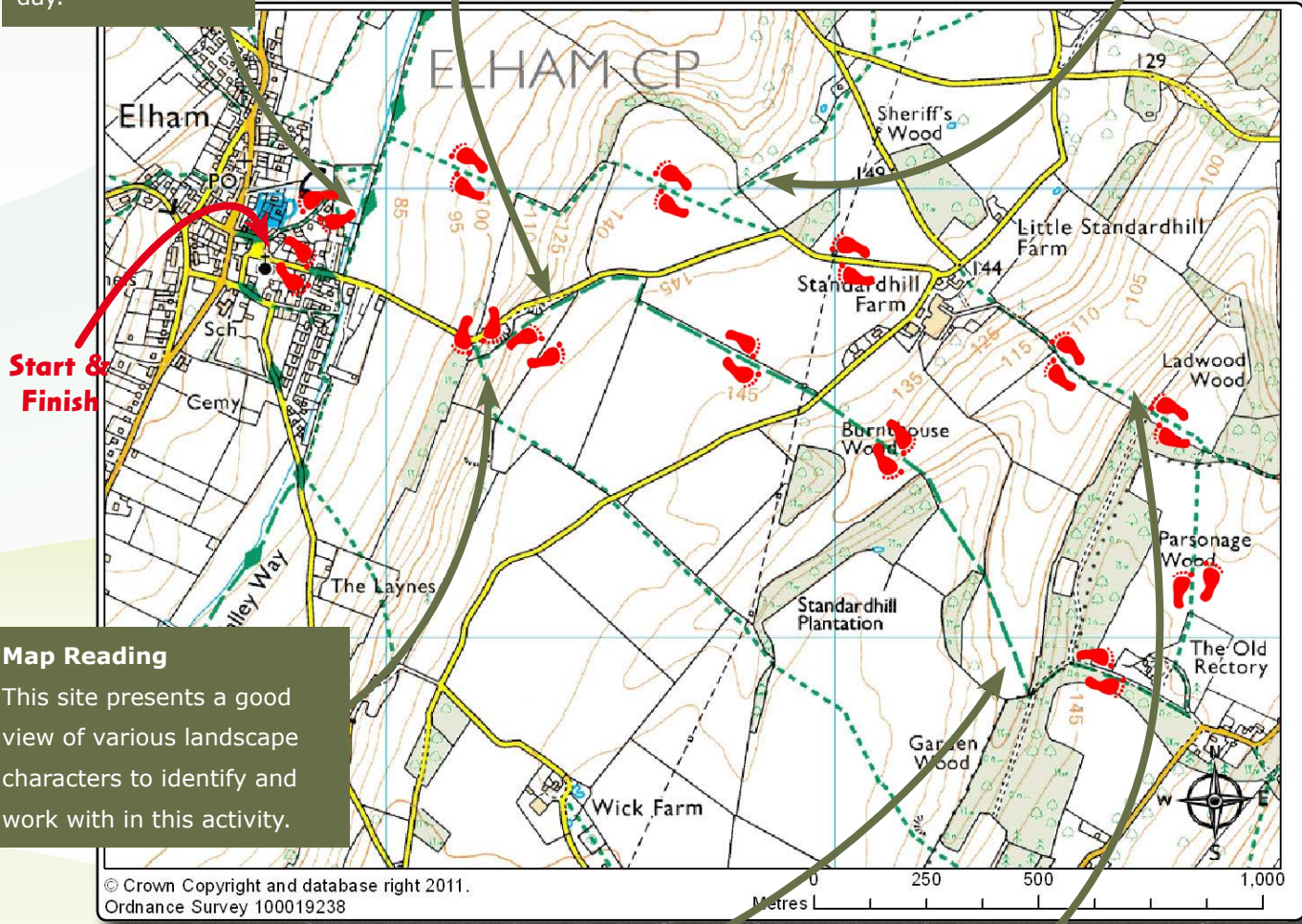
Discover an inspirational landscape near your school

Game
The game will reinforce the messages of the day.

AONB Landscape Features
Broad views and a chalk pit of the Kent Downs can be seen at this site from the road helping the children to imagine how the Kent Downs was formed.

Story
This creative story told by the leader will bring together the heritage of the Kent Downs and reveal the walk leaders secret.



Map Reading
This site presents a good view of various landscape characters to identify and work with in this activity.

Living Things and Habitats
This area is surrounded by habitats which will be recognised by the children on the habitats work sheet.

Literacy
