Locate a footpath on the map and label it 'footpath'.

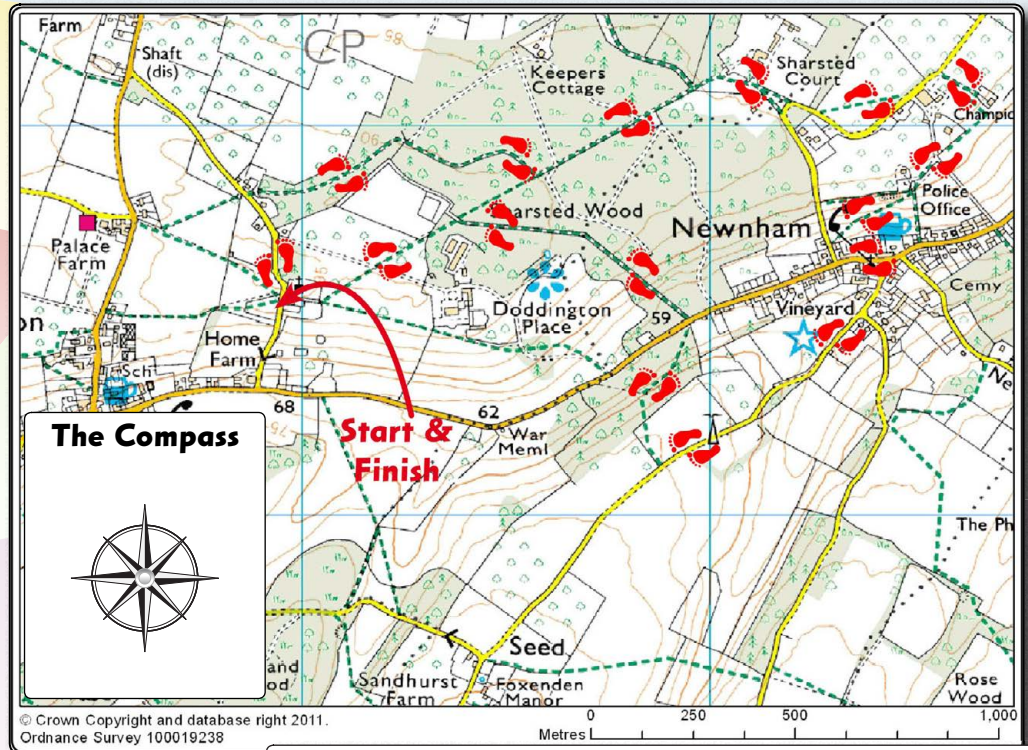
