



Discover an inspirational landscape near your school

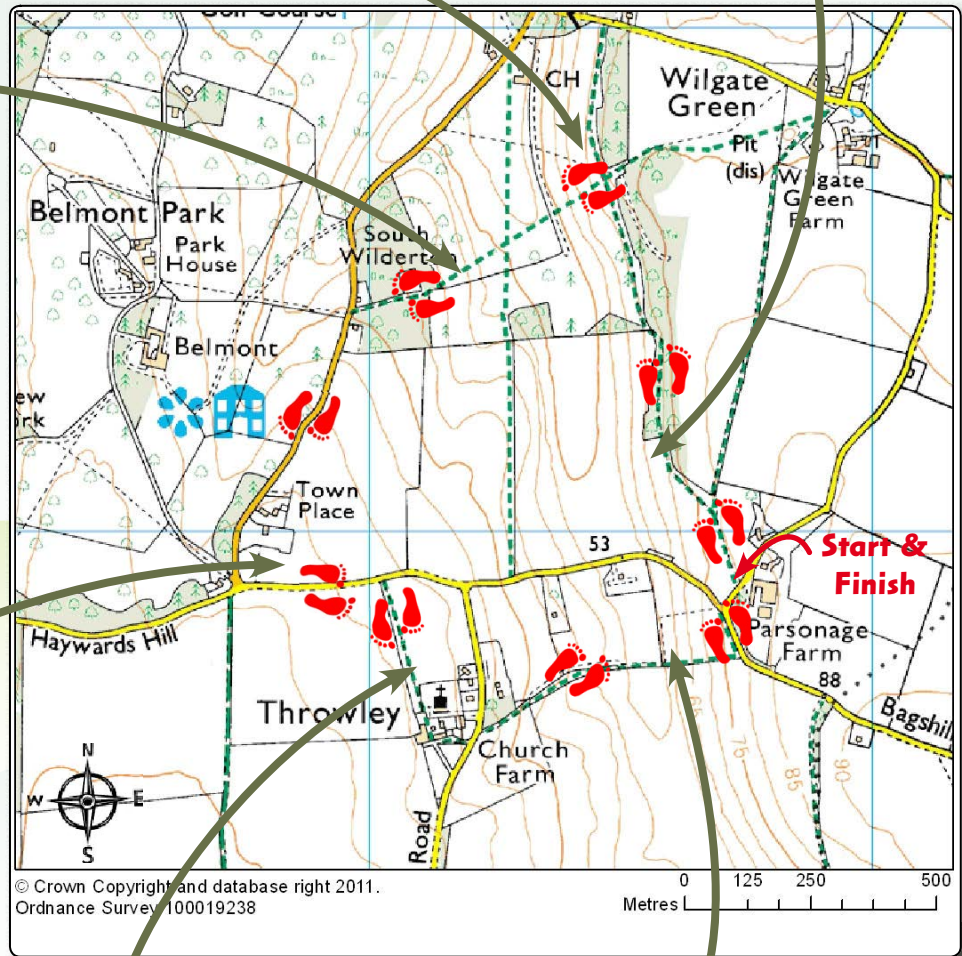
Throwley Walk with suggested activity sites

Map Reading
 This site presents a good view of various landscape characters to identify and work with in this activity.

AONB Landscape Features
 Broad views of the Kent Downs can be seen from this site helping the children to imagine how the Kent Downs was formed.

Living Things and Habitats
 This area is surrounded by habitats which will be recognised by the children on the habitats work sheet.

Literacy
 The children will experience the use of their senses such as smell, hearing, touch and sight. These experiences can then be used in the literacy activity by writing a poem.



Story
 This creative story told by the leader will bring together the heritage of the Kent Downs and reveal the walk leaders secret.

Game
 The game will reinforce the messages of the day.

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
